No Longer One Crop. Now the Whole Country.

The Vanuatu Impact Fund is an innovative pathway to Vanuatu citizenship through the Capital Investment Immigration Programme (CIIP). It is available only through Stanford Knight & Partners, the government's appointed Master Agent, and it combines citizenship with sustainable investment in Vanuatu's primary sector.

The fund launched in 2024 as the Vanuatu Coffee Impact Fund, focused on organic Arabica on the island of Tanna. It is now approved to operate across the primary sector nationally: coffee, cacao, vanilla and kava, on smallholdings throughout the archipelago. Capital is never exposed to any single crop, island or season.

The structure is unchanged. You invest USD \$50,000, capital is independently managed under a capital preservation policy, and the investment is returned in full after four years.

Coffee

Volcanic soils on Tanna produce some of the Pacific's highest-quality organic Arabica. The fund's founding sector, and still its deepest.

Cacao

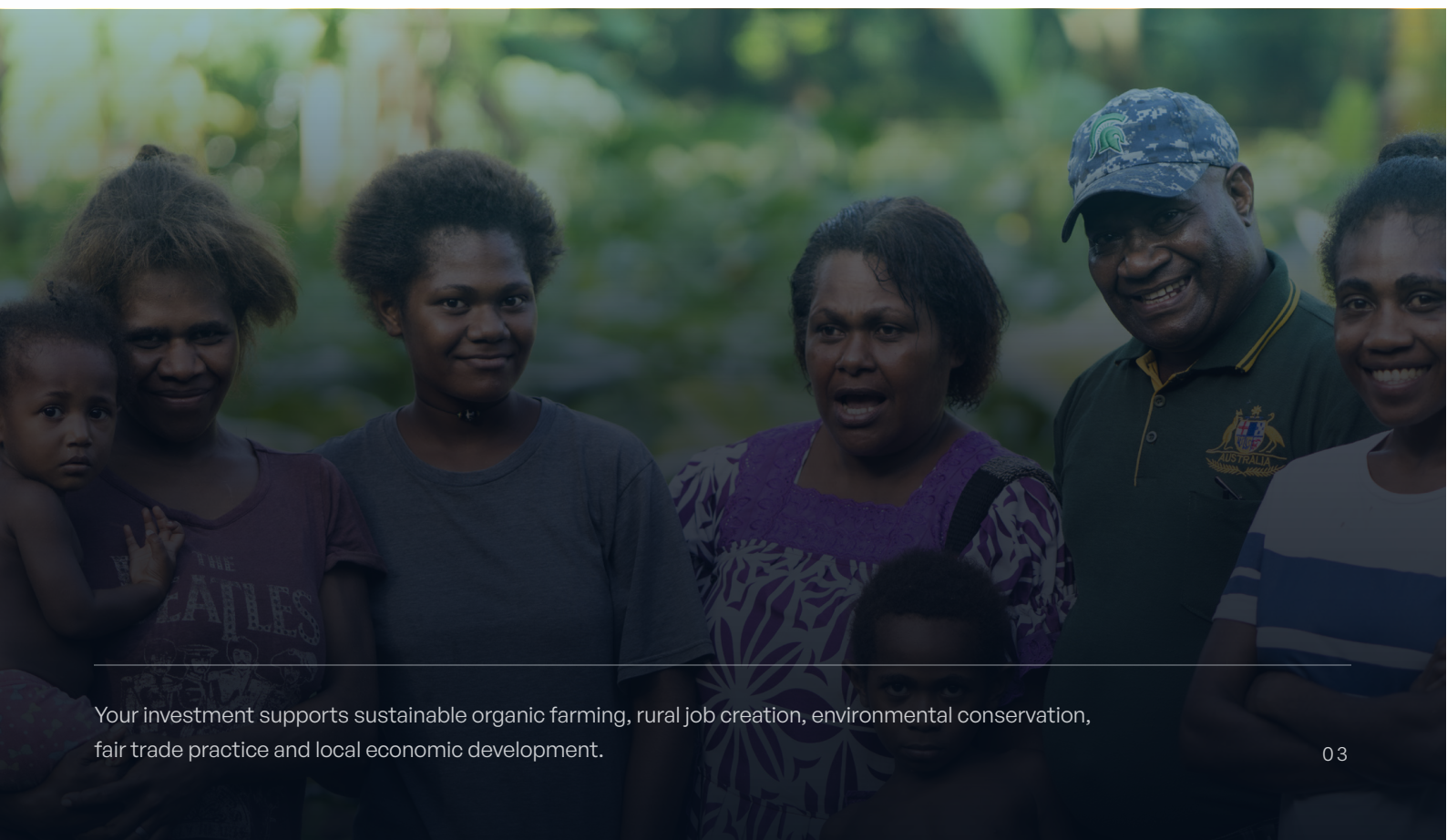
A long-established Vanuatu export with rising specialty demand. Fermentation and drying infrastructure lifts smallholder margins directly.

Vanilla

High value per hectare and well suited to smallholdings. Curing quality is the constraint, and the constraint is investable.

Kava

One of Vanuatu's leading exports and a mainstay of rural income. Processing, grading and traceability are the growth path.



Your investment supports sustainable organic farming, rural job creation, environmental conservation, fair trade practice and local economic development.

\$50,000 Invested. \$50,000 Returned.

The fund is professionally managed by independent fund managers who oversee strategic investment across Vanuatu's primary sector. Investors receive preferential shares in the fund holding company, with no requirement to establish a separate corporate structure.

YEAR 0

You invest \$50,000 in the fund as part of your CIIP application. Redeemable preferential share certificates are issued in the holding company.

YEARS 1-4

Capital is deployed across coffee, cacao, vanilla and kava nationally. Fund reports are produced regularly, including independent annual impact reporting.

YEAR 4

The fund manager contacts you to arrange redemption of the investment along with any returns. Effective cost of citizenship: \$115,000.

Independently managed

All investment into the primary sector is made as mandated by the Government of Vanuatu, under a capital preservation policy targeting a feasible 5–6% per annum. Capital is never exposed to any single sector.

No company registration

There is no requirement to register a separate company. The fund issues CIIP investors preferential shares in the holding company, and the shares are redeemable at the end of the four-year term.

01 Book your consultation

A confidential conversation with a senior adviser. We assess eligibility and recommend the right programme. 45–60 minutes.

03 Document collection

A checklist tailored to your circumstances, uploaded through our secure client portal. 7–14 days.

05 Application preparation

Every document reviewed, verified and formatted to government standards, and checked twice before submission. 5–7 days.

07 Approval, oath and passport

The oath of allegiance is administered remotely via consulate or embassy, then your passport is issued and delivered securely. 7–14 days.

02 Engage Stanford Knight

A clear engagement letter setting out scope, timeline, costs and responsibilities. An initial deposit secures your place. 1–2 days.

04 Due diligence and processing

Background checks, financial verification and sanctions screening by the Commission. Days 5–21.

06 Government submission

Lodged directly with the Citizenship Commission by our Port Vila team. Our office is adjacent, so queries are handled same-day. 1 day.

What you will need

Certified passport copy, birth certificate, police clearance, bank reference and statements, proof of address, CV, photographs, source of funds declaration and a basic medical certificate.
